AOC Bordeaux 2010

- **VINEYARD:**

Surface: 4Ha

Soil : clay and limestone with stone

Grapes : Merlot (80%) Cabernet Sauvignon (20%)



- **TASTING:**

Appearance : Red rubis colour

Nose: Delicate aromas of red fruit, liquorice and spice.

Palate: Nice balance tannins and acidity that support flavours of forest fruit and spice, with a lengthy satisfying finish.

Pairing : great with red and white meat.

AWARD : Gold medal at the 'Wines of Aquitaine Competition' 2012 & 2010 and Silver medal in 2011.

- **VINIFICATION:**

Fermentation in stainless steel tank during 3 weeks, and did a malolactic fermentation.
